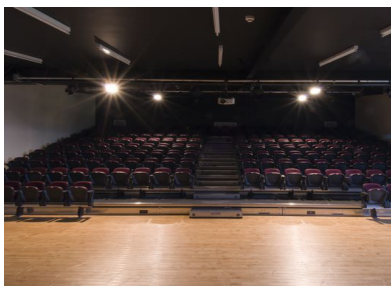


PFI Sixth Form Developments

Our Role

Provelio has been commissioned to project manage a number of sixth form extensions; these are particularly complex due to the PFI nature of the proposed projects and the existing school buildings. The sixth form extension projects involve several months of legal negotiations regarding the build and future service delivery, prior to any build work being undertaken. After these initial stages Provelio project manage the development through to completion, this includes decant, move management, fit out and reconfiguration of parts of the original school building. The role also extends to training and Provelio have provided workshops to senior management staff of these schools on change management.
